## Notes

<sup>1</sup>The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under the new curriculum.

<sup>2</sup>Non-STEM graduates are required to take Math 20 or pass the Validation Examination for Math 20.

<sup>3</sup>All students required to take Math 21 must have passed any of the following: (1) Pre-Calculus from STEM or equivalent strand of K-12; (2) the Validation Examination for Math 20 (Pre-Calculus: Functions and their Graphs) administered by the UPD Institute of Mathematics, or (3) Math 20 as a non-credit course.

<sup>4</sup>For BM Elective courses, students may choose from the following list of Approved Elective Courses: 8M 102, 127, 144,145, 148, 168, 174, 178, 198.

Junior Standing: A student must have passed 66 units including BM 99.1, BM 99.2, Econ 101 & Econ 102. Senior Standing: A student must have passed 99 units.

As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in one of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officer's Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD.
