*As per Official Gazette post, President Benigno S. Aquino III signed Proclamation No. 84 entitled DECLARING THE REGULAR HOLIDAYS, SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS, AND SPECIAL HOLIDAY (FOR ALL SCHOOLS) FOR THE YEAR 2011. According to the Proclamation No. 84, the Philippines 2011 holidays are categorized into three: Regular Holidays, Special Non-Working Days and Special Holidays (for all schools). The proclamation also has provisions for the national holidays in observance of Eid' l Ftr and Eidul Adha, but the exact dates are still to be determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar.*
