Per Official Gazette post, President Benigno S. Aquino III signed Proclamation No. 459 entitled DECLARING THE REGULAR HOLIDAYS, SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS, AND SPECIAL HOLIDAY (FOR ALL SCHOOLS) FOR THE YEAR 2013.

According to the Proclamation No.459, the Philippines' 2013 holidays are categorized into three: Regular Holidays, Special Non-Working Days and Special Holiday (for all schools).

The proclamation also has provisions for the national holidays in observance of Eid'ul Fitr and Eid ul Adha, but the exact dates are still to be determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar.
