* If a transferee has already taken a math course in her/his previous course/University, Math 2 need not be prescribed anymore.

**24 units electives could be Tourism or Non-Tourism courses. Tourism electives include Tour 116, 117, 118, 145, 166, 167, 168, and 197. Non-tourism electives refer to any subjects from the Social Sciences and Philosophy, Arts and Humanities, and Math, Science and Technology domains/clusters with course number 100 and above. Foreign language courses, regardless of course number, are considered as electives. If taking foreign language (other than Filipino, English, and the native language of a foreign student), a student must take 12 units provided all 12 units are in one language.

As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in one of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officer's Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD.

The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under the new curriculum.
