NOTES:

¹GE Elective are courses offered by the UP System that fall under the GE program.

²Free electives are courses in any discipline in the UP System and not part of the GE program.

³Language electives are any foreign language or Philippine language courses except English and Filipino.

⁴Film Electives are film courses offered by the Film Institute which include but are not limited to Film 106, Film 112, Film 130, Film 134, Film 135, Film 152, Film 175, Film 176, Film 178, Film 180, Film 196 and Film 197.

Film 180, Film 196 and Film 197 may be taken twice provided they are different topics.

As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in one of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officers' Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD.

If a transferee has already taken a Math course in his/her previous course/University, Math 2 need not be prescribed anymore.

The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under the new curriculum
