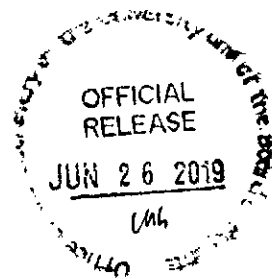

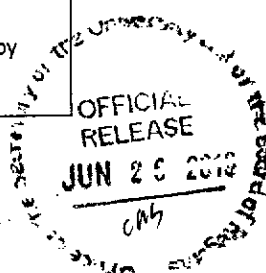
*Sequencing of Psych 155, 170, and 124 depends on student's plans for the type of practicum he or she will undertake
