**NOTES:**

1. Cognate Courses may be taken from at least two of the following disciplines or studies, twelve (12) units of which must be in courses numbered above 100, subject to the advising and approval of the Department :

Anthropology, Art Studies, Broadcast Communication, Economics, English and Comparative Literature, Foreign Languages, Geography, History, Journalism, Linguistics, Mathematics, Philosophy, Filipino and/or Philippine Literature, Psychology, Public Administration, Sociology, Statistics, and Speech Communication and Theatre Arts.

2. All students required to take Math 21 must have passed any of the following: (1) Pre-Calculus from the STEM or equivalent strand of K-12; (2) the Validation Examination for Math 20 (Pre-Calculus: Functions and their Graphs) administered by the UPD Institute of Mathematics; or (3) Math 20 as a non-credit course.

3. Socio 180 Social Statistics may be taken in place of Soc Sci 103.

4. Graduate cognate courses can be taken in the following disciplines/areas:

Anthropology, Linguistics, Asian Studies, Philippine Studies, Economics, Public Administration, Geography, Sociology, History, Islamic Studies, and such other areas that may be designated and allowed by the Graduate Faculty.

5. The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under the new curriculum.

Note: As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in of the following National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officers' Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD.
