2 or equivalent strand of K-12; (2) the Validation Examination for Math 20 (Pre-Calculus: Functions and their  
3 Graphs) administered by the UPD Institute of Mathematics; or (3) Math 20 as a non-credit course.

4 <sup>2</sup> Must be from the fields of Math, Science and Technology, except Math 2.

5 <sup>3</sup> Any course in any College numbered 100 and above subject to approval of adviser. Allow non-BA electives  
6 below 100 only for international language courses (besides English) or a course which is a prerequisite to  
7 another non-BA elective.

8 <sup>4</sup> A maximum of four (4) electives may be taken in any particular business discipline to achieve depth.

12 As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in one of the National Service Training  
13 Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and  
14 Reserved Officer's Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD.

16 The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program  
17 shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved  
18 for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under  
19 the new curriculum.
