SUBJECT:

Graduation with honors for Second Degree

At its 03 March 2015 meeting, the CSAPG clarified the rule on graduation with honors for students admitted in the Second Degree program:

- 1. In the case of a second degree student who earned his/her first degree in UP:
- a. A second degree student who earned the first degree in the University is eligible for honors, because she has complied with the 75% requirement (considering that s/he took all courses in the university).
- b. That grades in all subjects prescribed in the curriculum including subjects taken and credited in the first degree (for example GE courses), shall be included in the computation of the weighted average grade.
- c. Must have been in residence therein for at least two (2) years immediately prior to graduation.
- d. Sample case and curriculum is attached as Annex 1.
- 2. In the case of a second degree student who earned his/her first degree in another University:

- a. Must complete in the University at least 75% of the total number of academic units for graduation based on the curriculum;
- b. Must have been in residence therein for at least two (2) years immediately prior to graduation.
- c. Student is not allowed to take courses outside the curriculum to complete the 75% requirement in the program. However, they may opt to retake GE courses, which would otherwise be eligible for advance credit to comply with the 75% requirement.
- d. For those who earned their bachelor's degree from another University, see/FOLLOW Transfer Admission from other Universities. (UPD Catalogue page 32 Second Degrees)
- e. Validation for Advance Credit is applicable to a Second Degree student. Form for Advance Credit without Validation should be filled out to credit courses taken in the First Degree (e.g. GE courses).
- f. All upper division courses required in the program (as DETERMINED BY THE UNIT) shall be taken in the University. (UPD catalogue, page 7-Transfer admission from other universities.
- g. Sample case and curriculum in Annex 2.

- 1. 75% of required course of 144 is 108 units. Student had taken 111 units in UP. Student need to take GE courses in UP to comply the 75% to graduate with honors(STS, Arkiyoloji 1, Archeo 2, Socio 10 and Geol 1). Had taken the 6 units requirement of Phil Studies in UP.
- 2. Student need to seek approval of advance credit without validation on courses taken from other university (First Degree) which has equivalent in UP.
